SIX THINGS you need to know about **Haiti adoption before you call.**

- 1.** Childless, heterosexual married couples between the ages of 35-50 are eligible to adopt from Haiti.
- 2.** Childless, single heterosexual women who are living alone and between the ages of 35-50, are also eligible to adopt from Haiti.
- 3.** Married couples must be married at least 10 years to be considered unless the couple is infertile.
- 4.** Families may have no more than 2 adopted children under the age of 18 living in their home, and have no biological children to be considered for adoption from Haiti.
- 5.** The children currently arriving in the U.S. from Haiti were already declared orphans prior to the earthquake had been referred to families in the adoption process for Haiti prior to the earthquake. It is uncertain new adoptions from Haiti will resume, but families should be prepared for a lengthy process to complete an adoption.
- 6.** The organization that Dillon works with in Haiti prefers to only work with Christian families for adoption placement.
