**Required skills and experience:**

1. High School Diploma (or G.E.D.) preferred. Prior related experience in a long-term care setting preferred.
2. Requires knowledge of procedures required to operate the Laundry in a clean, safe and sanitary manner. Requires knowledge of and ability to comply with established sanitation procedures.
3. Requires ability to follow infection control practices that may vary to include universal precautions as well as isolation procedures.
4. Requires proficient ability to speak, read, and write English; requires proficient ability to understand business documents and verbal and written instructions given in English.
5. Requires ability to clearly communicate verbally with residents, families, visitors and co-workers. Requires ability to make self clearly understood by others.
6. Requires the ability to understand and follow basic written and oral step-by-step instructions.
7. Requires ability to operate or learn to operate laundry cleaning and related machines and equipment.
8. Requires ability to change temperature and water levels as necessary; determine the load of a machine can carry efficiently and estimate amount of washing required for variety of items; control temperature of iron or ironer.
9. Requires ability to perform routine, repetitive tasks on a continuous basis.
10. Requires the ability to move laundry carts/equipment throughout the facility, using up to 50 pounds of force occasionally, and/or up to 20 pounds of force frequently, and/or a small amount of force continuously to move objects and/or people.
11. Work deals mostly with objects, equipment and/or machines where the job is at or within arm's reach. Depth perception and field of vision (peripheral) are of some importance.
12. Requires sufficient strength, mobility and stamina to make frequent location and position changes, unload carts, load washers and push loaded carts up ramps.
13. Requires ability to turn, stoop, kneel, crouch, reach, push, pull, handle, stand, and walk over 75% of shift.
14. Requires the ability to recognize differences in sound, such as voices/noises that are loud and playful instead of angry and combative.
15. Requires the ability to recognize differences in sound generated by equipment or machinery which may indicate operating problems or safety concerns.
16. Requires the ability to learn to adjust and operate electric-powered laundry equipment.
17. Requires the ability to perform tasks with due consideration for residents and co-workers in vicinity; ability to cooperate and work with other team players and teams.
18. Requires the ability to work under limited supervision performing routine, standardized tasks.
19. Requires commitment to Christian principles and teachings both professionally and personally.
20. Requires sufficient good health to properly discharge duties. Employees shall not be permitted to work who have infectious disease or skin lesion, for the duration of the communicability.
21. Requires ability to change duties quickly and to adapt to new projects.
